Current Health Policies/Procedures

- **Temperature Monitoring** Any student with a temperature of or greater than 100.0 F (oral) or 99.5 (temporal) will be excluded from school. The student may return when fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication.
- Sending Sick Students Home from School Students exhibiting symptoms from the Covid-19 Symptom Table below will be sent home from school and advised to seek further medical evaluation from their health care provider.
- **Standing Order on Medications -** Due to Covid-19 interactions, medication such as Tylenol, Ibuprofen, and TUMS will not be administered to a student unless that student has a medication order from their own private healthcare provider.
- Monitoring for Symptoms Monitor your child's temperature before sending them to school. If your child is sick with symptoms of Covid-19 (SEE BELOW), keep your child home from school and consult with your child's healthcare provider.
 - *Please do not send your child to school with an injury or illness for the nurse to diagnose.*
